



## **TIME TO VISIT THE H2O TODAY EXHIBITION AT SCI-BONO DISCOVERY CENTRE!**

With the Schools in Gauteng beginning the Academic year with the Vaal Dam a little over half full, Water education is now more important than ever.

The Smithsonian's H2O TODAY is an immersive exhibition that informs and teaches Learners from Junior to Senior School about all things water. The water cycle, mining and water, water in industrial use, water in science, pollution in water catchments and other resources including ocean and also alleviation of affecting endangered species amongst other subjects.

The Exhibition is hosted by four young actors who act as tour guides and also perform two musical plays suitable for all ages.

There are touchscreens, 21 Video screens, four 3d Art creations and a painting section to capture the imagination of young visitors.

A suggested length of visit is 90 minutes without visiting the other 400 interactive exhibits at Sci-Bono. We recommend a minimum of two hours.
